- Videos must be between 60-90 seconds in length
- Contest runs between June 1, 2021 and August 30, 2021
- Email, hand in a USB, or electronically transfer your video to communications@lacombecounty.com (you can use online file sharing programs like WeTransfer <https://wetransfer.com/>).
- Winning videos will be selected by a committee of Lacombe County representatives. Prizes will be presented as follows:
 - \$150 for 1st Place
 - \$100 for 2nd Place
 - \$50 for 3rd Place
- Selected videos will be featured in a Farm Safety Film Festival in fall 2021.

Contest Rules:

- Video must be between 60 – 90 seconds
- Student must be between 9 and 18 years old and attend a school within Lacombe County. This can include children who are homeschooled.
- More than one student can make a video, but all participants must have a guardian sign the release (above).
- Videos must highlight a safe farm activity or behaviour. **We will not accept any videos depicting dangerous behaviour.**
- Content closes are 11:50PM on August 30, 2021
