Mrs. Knight advised that she recently received an inquiry regarding the Connex bus in Lacombe. Mrs. Knight commented that she thought Connex had expanded their service outside Lacombe but when the ratepayer called they advised that Connex only goes 20 km. outside of Lacombe. This issue was brought up during ICF discussions and there will be a review of the service in which Lacombe County will take part.
