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**POLICY STATEMENT**

Lacombe County is committed to delivering cost-effective services that best meet the needs of our taxpayers and community. We support and participate in the ~~Jubilee RMA Insurance RiskPro Training~~ Risk Management Program to help ~~the County~~ achieve the following goals:

- The active control and reduction of ~~County~~ insurance and other risk-related costs;
- The protection of the interests of the stakeholders in ~~the~~ community;
- The prevention of losses arising from damage to community assets and liability claims;
- The reasonable assurance of uninterrupted municipal operations and delivery of services to ~~County~~ community stakeholders;
- When losses cannot be prevented, to ensure that the impact of losses on the organization and ~~County~~ community stakeholders is as minimal as possible.

To help ensure a mutual benefit for Lacombe County and other municipal districts and counties in the province of Alberta, ~~the County~~ also supports the exchange of knowledge and information with other municipal districts and counties that are participating in RMA Insurance's Risk Management ~~the Jubilee RiskPro Training~~ Program.

Council hereby delegates to the County ~~Manager~~ Commissioner the authority and responsibility to designate:

- A Risk Control Coordinator, to facilitate Lacombe County's progress through the RMA Insurance's Risk Management ~~Jubilee RiskPro Training~~ Program training process and the implementation of risk improvements;
- ~~A Risk Control Committee~~, A Risk Control Committee comprised of ~~representatives from key departments~~ members of the senior leadership team that will help implement risk improvements within the community organization.
