Mr. Stephenson advised he has had an inquiry from a ratepayer regarding the County doing an in-service on the matter.	Mr. Timmons advised that no course has been provided. Mr. Timmons commented that the County provides water well and sewer system courses and that articles are published in the County News regarding land draining.		
Mr. Stephenson commented there are rules and regulations as to what a landowner can do and what they are responsible for.	Mr. Timmons commented that the County is getting more proactive on drainage issues and getting information out to landowners. Mr. Timmons added that the County does not have jurisdiction in the area of drainage and Alberta Environment should be promoting information in this regard. Mr. Timmons advised he will follow up on this matter with Alberta Environment.

Mrs. Knight inquired if an additional sign could be erected advising that ice shacks must be off the lake by the end of March.</p>	<p>Mr. Cade advised that the road is Lacombe County's jurisdiction therefore the sign can refer to the road. The Take It Off the Lake signs are not regulated by the County. Mrs. Knight commented she will bring this issue to the Buffalo Lake Management Team so they can approach the province regarding this matter.</p>
