

BYLAW NO. 1369/22

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE LACOMBE COUNTY LAND USE BYLAW, BYLAW NO. 1237/17 AS IT RELATES TO DEFINITIONS AND DISTRICT USES.

WHEREAS notice was given of Council's intention to amend the Land Use Bylaw in the following local newspapers:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Lacombe County under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c.M-26-1, as amended, enacts that the Land Use Bylaw be amended as follows:

1. PART 1 – DEFINITIONS

1.6 Definitions

Add the following definition:

RECOVERY CENTRE means a centre for the treatment of persons with addiction, such as but not limited to drugs or alcohol, which may include the provision of services including psychotherapy and the dispensing of medication, but does not include detoxification. This includes providing overnight or short-term accommodation to residents but does not include a detention or correction centre.

2. PART 7 – LAND USE DISTRICTS

7.1 AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT (A)

2 Uses

Add Discretionary use:

Recovery Centre on W½ Pt. SW-16-39-01-W5M
