## DIVISION GRADER OPERATOR

Lacombe County is looking for a skilled and experienced Grader Operator for our Division 7 (Eckville area). This **permanent, full-time position** is based out of the Sylvan Lake Remote Shop (civic address: 2517 Twp Rd 400). Reporting to the Maintenance Foreman, the Grader Operator is responsible for operating the grader in a safe and effective manner in order to ensure the roadways are accessible and in good condition for the residents and visitors of Lacombe County.

### Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain gravel roads, right-of-ways and lanes in a logical order to maximize efficiency;
- Perform dust control applications;
- Perform snow removal on paved and gravel roads;
- Complete miscellaneous maintenance projects;
- Perform daily and routine safety and maintenance checks of the equipment to maximize the life of the machine;
- Work under extreme and changing climate conditions. Work in physically demanding conditions and perform physical labour, heavy lifting, and climbing.

### Ideal Qualifications:

- Must have considerable grader operation experience in the maintenance or construction of roads;
- Must possess, and be able to maintain, a valid class 5 Alberta driver's license (a current abstract is to be submitted prior to date of hire). A Class 3 or Class 1 is an asset;
- Possess a strong mechanical aptitude - able to perform light maintenance and servicing of the equipment;
- Possess strong sensory skills, including the ability to exercise judgment based on weight, balance, speed and depth perception;
