Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Participate in workplace safety initiatives and meetings as required. Report to work fit for duty;
- Operate basic hand and power tools.

Ideal Qualifications:

- Enjoy working outdoors and able to perform duties in adverse weather conditions;

- Able to perform strenuous work, including the ability to lift and move objects of up to 50lbs;
